An Act to Establish a Date for Removal of Fishing Shacks from Tidal Waters.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec.1. 12 MRSA §6523-A is enacted to read:

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§6523-A. Ice fishing shack removal

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8 The owner of any shack or temporary structure used for ice
10 fishing on frozen coastal waters shall remove the shack or
12 temporary structure by March 15. Failure to comply with this
14 section is a civil violation. The fine or penalty for conviction
16 of violating this section must include the costs incurred in
18 removing any structure.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill sets March 15 as the date when all ice fishing shacks must be removed from tidal waters. The fine for violating this requirement must include the cost of removing the structure.
