14	services that are within the lawful scope of practice of a counselor licensed to practice in this State, any person covered
16	by the policy or contract is entitled to reimbursement for these services if the services are performed by a counselor licensed to
18	practice in this State. The payment or reimbursement may not be conditioned upon prior diagnosis or referral by a physician or
20	other health care professional, except in cases where diagnosis of the condition for which the services are rendered is beyond
22	the scope of licensure of the counselor.
24	2. Coverage not required. Nothing in subsection 1 may be construed to require a health insurance policy or contract
