

**Resolve, Directing the Department of Environmental Protection to Study
the Safety of Seafood in Maine Waters.**

2 **Sec. 1. Study and report required. Resolved:** That the
3 Department of Environmental Protection shall conduct within
4 existing resources a study to determine the public health safety
5 of seafood caught in all Maine waters in order to locate the
6 sources of pollution. The department must include with its
7 report recommendations and priorities for corrective measures,
8 with cost estimates when feasible. The department must report
9 its conclusions no later than January 15, 1994. The report must
10 be submitted to the office of the Executive Director of the
11 Legislative Council for distribution to the Joint Standing
12 Committee on Marine Resources.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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17 This resolve authorizes the Department of Environmental
18 Protection to conduct a study of the public health safety of
19 seafood caught in Maine waters.
