COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "^A " to S.P. 38, L.D. 50, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Requirements for Notice of Public Proceedings of the Public Utilities Commission"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and 18 inserting in its place the following:

20 'Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §108, as amended by PL 1987, c. 614, § 1, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 35-A MRSA §108-A is enacted to read:

<u>§108-A. Commission action; quorum; notice</u>

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A majority of the duly appointed commissioners constitutes a 28 guorum and the act or decision of a majority of commissioners present, if at least a quorum is present, is the act or decision 30 of the commission in any formal proceeding before the commission.

Notwithstanding Title 1, section 406, the commission is 32 required to give notice of public proceedings only if the 34 commission will deal with the expenditure of public funds or if the commission will make any of the following decisions in 36 proceedings before it: a decision to initiate rulemaking or to adopt or modify a rule pursuant to Title 5, chapter 375, 38 subchapter II; a decision making an advisory ruling pursuant to Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter III; a decision to commence an adjudicatory proceeding, an interim decision in an adjudicatory 40 proceeding that will affect the substantive or procedural rights of any party, or a final decision at the conclusion of an 42 adjudicatory proceeding, all pursuant to Title 5, chapter 375, 44 subchapter IV; or a decision in any other proceeding pursuant to this Title or the commission's rules that requires commission approval or decision. In addition, if the commission is 46 participating as a party in a proceeding before a federal agency

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and the commission will adopt a position in that federal
proceeding, the commission shall give to other parties from the
State who are participating in the federal proceeding notice of
the public proceeding at which the commission may adopt that
position.

FISCAL NOTE

The Public Utilities Commission will incur some minor additional administrative costs to pay for increased advertising costs for the required public notices. These costs can be absorbed within the commission's existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This amendment modifies the public notice requirements for Public Utilities Commission meetings. Under current law, the commission is required to give notice of meetings in which the commission will deal with the expenditure of public funds or 22 taxation or will adopt policy. Current law provides a listing of the types of actions that are deemed to involve the adoption of 24 policy.

26 Under this amendment, the commission will be required to provide notice of any meeting at which the commission by law or 28 rule is required to make a decision. In addition, the commission will be required to provide public notice for several specific 30 types of meetings. The commission will also be required to give limited notice of any meeting in which the commission may decide 32 to adopt a position before a federal agency.

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This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
