

An Act to Require the Department of Corrections to Provide Certain
Services to Juveniles.

18 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

20 This bill amends the law defining the responsibility of the
22 Department of Corrections to provide certain prevention, support
and rehabilitation services to juveniles by removing language
that limited that responsibility to the availability of funds.
