An Act Regarding the Issuance of Special License Plates.

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §252-J is enacted to read:

This bill creates a special license plate for rescue unit workers and emergency medical services' personnel. It also provides for a \$50 forfeiture for failure by inactive rescue workers to return recalled license plates to the Secretary of State.
