

**Resolve, Concerning Long-term Protection from Low-level Radioactive
Waste.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 **Sec. 1. Study authorized. Resolved:** That the Low-level
6 Radioactive Waste Authority shall conduct an analysis and review
8 of the feasibility of separating long-lived and short-lived
10 radioactive waste streams in waste generated by the Maine Yankee
12 Atomic Power Company; and be it further

14 **Sec. 2. Report. Resolved:** That the Low-level Radioactive
16 Waste Authority shall present its findings to the joint standing
18 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over energy and
20 natural resource matters by November 1, 1993.

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This resolve directs the Low-level Radioactive Waste
18 Authority to study the feasibility of separating long-lived and
20 short-lived radioactive waste streams in waste from the Maine
 Yankee Atomic Power Company.
