12 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 46, L.D. 68, Bill, "An Act 14 to Prohibit Greyhound Racing in Maine"

16 Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its 18 place the following:

'Sec. 1. 8 MRSA c. 12 is enacted to read:

CHAPTER 12

GREYHOUND RACING

 A person may not hold, conduct or operate greyhound racing for public exhibition. A person may not transmit or receive
interstate simulcasting of greyhound racing for commercial purposes.

<u>§302. Penalty</u>

A person who violates this chapter is subject to a civil 36 penalty of not less than \$7,500 payable to the State.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

6 This amendment prohibits the transmitting or receiving of interstate simulcasting of greyhound racing for commercial 8 purposes.

10 The bill made a violation of this chapter a Class D crime, but this amendment changes that to make a person who violates 12 this chapter subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$7,500, payable to the State.

This amendment is the majority report.
