2. Qualifications for voting. The qualifications for voting in a municipal election conducted under this Title are governed solely by Title 21-A, section 111, except that in town meetings and municipal elections conducted pursuant to this chapter, a person who owns property within a town or municipality but who resides elsewhere may vote on town or municipal affairs that would have a fiscal impact on that person.
