STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits the union committee in a school union to authorize the superintendent to handle all financial transactions relating to the school union's participation in a regional cooperative program. The superintendent may perform this function only when students from 2 or more municipalities in the union participate in a regional cooperative program.
