

**An Act to Cover Employees of the Maine National Guard under the
Maine Human Rights Act and the Whistleblowers' Protection Act.**

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §152 is enacted to read:

6 §152. Rights of members

8 Notwithstanding section 142, a member of the National Guard,
10 as defined in section 102, has all the protections, rights and
12 remedies provided by the Whistleblowers' Protection Act and the
14 Maine Human Rights Act.

16 STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill specifically extends the protections and rights
under the Whistleblowers' Protection Act and the Maine Human
Rights Act to members of the Maine Army National Guard and the
Maine Air National Guard.
