24	STATEMENT OF FACT
26	This amendment makes 2 substantive policy changes to the bill.
28	1. The original bill requires a person hunting a wild bird
30	or animal at any time to possess an archery hunting license. Current law only requires that such a license be obtained for
32	hunting deer during the special archery hunting season on deer. Under this amendment, current law will be maintained.
34	2. The amendment changes the effective date of the bill to
36	January 1, 1995.
