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An Act to Supplement and Maintain a Federal Grant to the Western  
Regional Council on Alcoholism, Incorporated.

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**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

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**Sec. 1. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
