

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1866, sub-§4, ¶¶A and B, as amended by PL
4 1991, c. 819, §7, are further amended to read:

7 A. In addition to the payment of the refund value, the
8 initiator of the deposit under section 1863-A, subsections
9 1, 2 and 4 shall reimburse the dealer or local redemption
10 center for the cost of handling beverage containers subject
11 to section 1863-A, in an amount that equals at least 3¢
12 2 1/2¢ per returned container.

13 B. In addition to the payment of the refund value, the
14 initiator of the deposit under section 1863-A, subsection 3
15 shall reimburse the dealer or local redemption center for
16 the cost of handling beverage containers subject to section
17 1863-A in an amount that equals at least 3¢ 2 1/2¢ per
18 returned container. The initiator of the deposit may
19 reimburse the dealer or local redemption center directly or
20 indirectly through a contracted agent.

STATEMENT OF FACT

27 This bill changes the amount that beverage deposit
28 initiators must reimburse the dealer or redemption center for the
29 cost of handling beverage containers from 3¢ to 2 1/2¢ per
30 container.
