

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §737, sub-§5-A is enacted to read:

6 5-A. Conduct of recount. Employees of the election
8 division within the Department of the Secretary of State shall
conduct ballot recounts. Except for elected officials, state
employees may not participate in ballot recounts.

12 STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This bill requires that ballot recounts be conducted by
16 election division employees only. No other state employees,
excepting elected officials who may be considered state
employees, may participate in recounts.
