COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 108, L.D. 150, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Effectiveness of Child Support Enforcement"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to include the parents' social security numbers on the birth certificates of their children. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

Other Special Revenue generated by child support collections may increase due to the additional information available to child support enforcement officers. To the extent these collections may be related to the Aid to Families with Dependent Children program, there may some General Fund savings. The amount can not be estimated at this time."

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
