## STATEMENT OF FACT

	Currently, persons who were practicing acupuncture in the
4	State as of August 9, 1989 are eligible for an acupuncture
	license if they have 1000 classroom hours in acupuncture, 300
б	hours of clinical experience and, as of August 9, 1989, had
	either 2 1/2 years of practice experience or 6 months of practice
8	experience, certification from a national commission and a
	bachelor's degree or nurse's license or evidence of progress
10	toward receiving that degree or license.
