36	This bill establishes a new Class D crime. Sentences imposed for Class D offenses must be served in a county jail. The average cost per sentence for a Class D crime is \$7,439 based

40	this new crime will not require reimbursement by the State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment requires a diver harvesting marine species by hand to display a "diver's down flag" when using scuba gear to harvest that species. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
