COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 121, L.D. 162, Bill, "An Act to Revise the Reciprocity Provisions for Licensing of Barbers and Cosmetologists"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill allows the Board of Barbering and Cosmetology to grant licenses to certain qualifying out-of-state practitioners and may result in an insignificant increase of dedicated revenues to the board from an increased amount of license fees.'

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill. This amendment is the minority report.
