FISCAL NOTE

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The additional costs to conduct an audit of certain unclassified positions in the executive branch and to report the findings to the Legislature can be absorbed by the Department of Administrative and Financial Services utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The amendment requires the Department of Administrative and Financial Services to identify all those positions in the executive branch that are currently unclassified and submit the appropriate legislation to change the positions to classified, with the exception of the commissioner and one deputy commissioner in each department. The amendment also provides the department with the option of requesting additional exemptions, provided the requests are made in writing and include a justification. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
