

2 Sec. 1. Department of Administrative and Financial Services
3 authorized to reclassify certain executive branch positions. Resolved:
4 That the Department of Administrative and Financial Services
5 shall reclassify the unclassified positions in the Maine Revised
6 Statutes, Title 5, sections 931 to 953-A in the executive branch
7 to classified positions. The department shall exempt the
8 commissioner and one additional employee in each department who
9 shall serve as the 2nd highest ranking employee in that
10 department.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This resolve requires the Department of Administrative and
15 Financial Services to reclassify certain executive branch
16 positions from unclassified to classified.

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
