2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §254**, as amended by PL 1991, c. 671, Pt. L,
§1 and affected by c. 780, Pt. R, §§8 and 10, is further amended
6 by adding after the 3rd paragraph a new paragraph to read:

8 In any year in which this program is conducted, it must
10 include psychotropic drugs and the amount that a recipient pays
toward the cost of any covered purchase is \$3 for generic or
single-source drugs or \$5 for brand-name, multisource drugs.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 This bill includes psychotropic drugs under the elderly
16 low-cost drug program.
