2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §254, as amended by PL 1991, c. 671, Pt. L,
4	§1 and affected by c. 780, Pt. R, §§8 and 10, is further amended by adding after the 3rd paragraph a new paragraph to read:
6	
8	In any year in which this program is conducted, it must include psychotropic drugs and the amount that a recipient pays
10	toward the cost of any covered purchase is \$3 for generic or single-source drugs or \$5 for brand-name, multisource drugs.
12	STATEMENT OF FACT
14	This bill includes psychotropic drugs under the elderly low-cost drug program.
