Expenditures required by this Act of funds other than the General Fund or the Highway Fund are authorized to exceed legislative allocations during the fiscal biennium. Appropriate adjustments to basic work programs facilitating these expenditures in excess of allocations must be recommended by the State Budget Officer and approved by the Governor.
