SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 138,
L.D. 183, Bill, "An Act to Remove the Repeal Date from the Laws
Governing Equitable Insurance Coverage for Mental Illness"


Amend the amendment in section 1 in paragraph E by striking
out all of the last sentence (page 2, lines 45 to 47 in
amendment) and inserting in its place the following: 'The
~~contracts may not contain a maximum lifetime benefit for any
mental illness listed in paragraph A.~~

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in paragraph E by
striking out all of the last sentence (page 4, lines 23 to 25 in
amendment) and inserting in its place the following: 'The
~~contracts may not contain a maximum lifetime benefit for any
mental illness listed in paragraph A.~~

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment repeals the provisions of the mental illness
benefits laws that prohibit contracts from having a lifetime
benefits cap on coverage for the listed mental illnesses. The
stricken language conflicts with the provisions added to the
Maine Revised Statutes, Title 24, section 2325-A, subsection 5-B,
paragraph E and Title 24-A, section 2843, subsection 5-B,
paragraph E in House Amendment "A."
