

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 **Sec. 1. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

14 Provides for the appropriation of funds for
16 2 demonstration projects, one in northern
18 Maine and one in southern Maine. Grants of
20 \$100,000 must be awarded through a
22 competitive bid process to 2 school
24 administrative units who shall contract with
community-based organizations to deliver
school-based services in areas including but
not limited to drug abuse prevention and
family planning.

26 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

28 This bill provides funds to the Department of Human Services
30 to award \$100,000 demonstration grants to 2 school administrative
units. The grants must be used to contract with community-based
organizations to deliver services in the schools.
