	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

6	13. Unlawfully operating ATV while under age. A person is guilty of unlawfully operating an ATV while under age, if:
8	A. That person is under the age of 19 12 years;
10 12	B. That person is under the age of 15 years and operates an ATV across any public way maintained for travel; Θr
14	C. That person is under 15 years of age and operates an ATV while unaccompanied by an adult <u>; or</u>

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill amends laws pertaining to age limitations on ATV operation by raising the minimum age for operating an ATV from 10 18 to 12 years; prohibiting a person between the ages of 12 and 16 years from operating an ATV with an engine size greater than 90 20 cubic centimeters; and expanding age restrictions to apply to ATV's operated on all private and public land in this State.
