HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 144,
L.D. 189, Bill, "An Act to Facilitate Municipal Road Construction"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the
following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the
enacting clause the following:

'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local
units of government to expand or modify activities so as to
necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does
not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures.
Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21,
two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have
determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

Further amend the amendment in the first line after the
title (page 1, line 16 in amendment) by striking out the
following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following:
'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 38 MRSA §480-Q, sub-§2-A, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1991,
c. 46, §3, is repealed.'

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires local units of government to make
additional expenditures resulting from the repeal of an exemption
in municipal permits for the repair and maintenance or

replacement of existing road culverts. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the 2/3 vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local cost of these requirements.'
