2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §2385-F** is enacted to read:

6 **§2385-F. Discounted rates**

8 An insurer shall discount by 20% the rate charged for
10 workers' compensation and employer liability insurance coverage
12 to an employer that has been approved for and is participating in
14 the "STAR" or "TRY" voluntary participation programs of the
United States Department of Labor, Occupational Safety and Health
Administration pursuant to The Occupational Safety and Health Act
of 1970, 29 United States Code, Sections 651-78, and the rules
and regulations promulgated pursuant to that Act.

16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

18 This bill grants a 20% discount on workers' compensation
20 insurance rates to an employer that has been approved for and
22 participates in the "STAR" or "TRY" voluntary participation
programs of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration of
the United States Department of Labor.
