	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7071, sub-§9 is enacted to read:

6	9. Persons prohibited from possessing firearm. A person who is prohibited from possessing a firearm under Title 15, section 393, subsection 1 is not eligible to obtain any license
8	or permit issued by the department that authorizes a person to
10	hunt with a firearm, unless that person possesses a permit in accordance with Title 15, section 393, subsection 2.
12	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7073, sub-§3-A is enacted to read:
14	3-A. Statement of right to possess firearms. An applicant for any license or permit that authorizes a person to hunt with a
16	firearm must sign a written statement, the form of which is determined by the commissioner by rule, verifying that:

20	A. The applicant is not prohibited by law from possessing a firearm pursuant to Title 15, section 393, subsection 1; or
