SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 159, L.D. 211, Bill, "An Act Related to Lottery Machines"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 4 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 24 and 25 in amendment) by striking out the following: "November 1, 1993" and inserting in its place the following: 'January 15, 1994'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 4 in the 6th line (page 1, line 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: "November 1, 1993" and inserting in its place the following: 'January 15, 1994'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 4 in the 8th line (page 1, line 29 in amendment) by striking out the following: "until" and inserting in its place the following: 'after January 15, 1994 unless'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 4 in the last line (page 1, line 30 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "implemented." the following: 'The removal of a lottery machine and the reason for removal must be reported to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over legal affairs.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services will incur some minor additional costs to develop a written plan

resources.'


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STATEMENT OF FACT
