to inform all applicants of the criteria and requirements for awarding and removing of lottery machines and to create a consistent and fair process for placement and removal of lottery machines in small as well as large stores.

The commission shall report to the Joint Standing Committee on Legal Affairs before November 1, 1993, so that the committee may review the plan. No more lottery machines may be removed from stores until a formal and equitable plan is implemented.

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This amendment also adds a fiscal note.
