

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1901, sub-§1, ¶¶A and B, as enacted by PL
4 1991, c. 785, §4 and affected by §5, are amended to read:

6 A. A greenhouse, except those associated with educational
7 institutions;

8 B. A nursery stock retail sales area in excess of 150 square

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

16 There is currently a \$25 annual fee for nursery owners who
17 maintain a greenhouse, a retail sales area in excess of 150
18 square feet or have gross sales of nursery stock in excess of
19 \$500.

20 This bill exempts from this fee owners of greenhouses
21 associated with educational institutions and requires the fee
22 only when the sales area for nursery stock, not the total sales
23 area, is over 150 square feet.
