

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

26 MRSA §1303, as amended by PL 1965, c. 406, §1, is
4 further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

6

All laborers employed in the construction of public works,
including state and interstate highways, must be provided with
health insurance that includes medical, hospital and major
medical insurance not less comprehensive than that currently
available through Maine Blue Alliance insurance providing for
usual and customary benefits.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill requires the provision of health insurance for
laborers on public works projects.
