STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill appropriates funds to enhance services provided by the Department of Human Services, Division for the Blind and Visually Impaired, including funds for one Computer Operator position in Bangor; 2 Teacher positions, one in York County and one in Washington County; and a Mobility Orientation Instructor position in the mid-coast area.
