Amend the resolution by striking out that part designated 18 section 23 (page 1, lines 7 to 9 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 23. State park land protected. The fee title to land
 acquired and held for state park or historic site purposes may be sold only if the proceeds of the sale are used to acquire other.
 state park or historic site land.'

26 Further amend the resolution by striking the referendum question (page 1, lines 24 and 25 in L.D.) and inserting in its 28 place the following:

30 '"Do you favor amending the Constitution of Maine to prohibit the sale of state park or historic site land unless
32 the proceeds are used to acquire other state park or historic site land?" '

Further amend the resolution by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The estimated cost of sending this constitutional resolution 42 out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the First Regular Session of the 116th 44 Legislature. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional 46 referendum costs an additional \$7,000.'

This amendment changes the language of the proposed amendment to the Maine Constitution to permit the sale of state park or historic site land only when the proceeds of the sale are used to acquire other state park or historic site land.
