

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 28-A MRSa §2509, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 45, Pt. A,  
4 §4, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

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**§2509. Limit on awards**

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In actions for damages permitted by this Act, the claim for  
and the award of damages for losses for any claim are not limited.

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**STATEMENT OF FACT**

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This bill eliminates the cap on awards of damages for losses  
under the Maine Liquor Liability Act.
