Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the 18 following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure."

Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 16 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

This bill may require local units of government to make additional expenditures to allow children to enter grade one at an earlier age. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the 2/3 vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the
