COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 187, L.D. 239, Bill, "An Act to Provide Assistance to Homeless Persons with Mental Illness"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

All Other	\$120,000	\$120,000
Provides funds to make grants to homeless shelter operators in the State's urban areas to assist them in meeting the needs of severely mentally ill persons who are being housed in homeless shelters. Funds must be allocated in accordance with a formula developed by the Bureau of Mental Health with input from the Maine Coalition for the Homeless.
