HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 87, L.D. 241, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Geographically Appropriate Placement for Nursing Home Residents"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRS §1867, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 780, Pt. R, §2, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

§1867. Distance restriction on placement of Medicaid recipients

The department may make Medicaid reimbursement for a nursing facility contingent on a maximum distance between a patient's home or hospital and the nursing facility if the maximum distance is not more than 60 miles.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment establishes a maximum distance requirement of 60 miles for Medicaid reimbursement for placement in nursing homes.
