SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 91, L.D. 245, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Purchase of Spirits at State Liquor Stores"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph B in the first line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "licensee" the following: 'or an agency'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 5.

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:


FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations will incur some minor additional costs to permit liquor licensees and agency liquor stores to purchase liquor from state liquor stores with a major credit card. These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment corrects a misstatement in the original bill by changing section 1 to allow a licensee or an agency to buy liquor at a state liquor store using cash or a credit card.

The amendment also strikes section 5 of the bill which would allow state liquor stores to deliver to establishments that are licensed to serve liquor on the premises.
