HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 92, L.D. 246, Bill, "An Act to Prevent Discrimination"

Amend the bill in section 2 by inserting at the end the following:

'A person is entitled to relief for discrimination based on sexual preference only if the person has declared sexual orientation at least 1 year prior to initiating a complaint under this Act. The declaration must be made on forms approved by the Secretary of State either upon application for a driver's license or upon registration to vote.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires that a person declare his or her sexual orientation either upon application for a driver's license or upon registration to vote in order to be eligible for relief under the Human Rights Act. The declaration must have been made at least 1 year before the initiation of a complaint under the Act.
