HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to S.P. 92, L.D. 246, Bill, "An Act to Prevent Discrimination"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 6. 5 MRSA §4633 is enacted to read:

§4633. Sexual orientation

The provisions of this chapter related to employment discrimination based on sexual orientation do not apply to a place of employment with fewer than 10 employees.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment exempts workplaces with fewer than 10 employees from the provisions included in the bill.
