HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to S.P. 92, L.D. 246, Bill, "An Act to Prevent Discrimination"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 6. 5 MRSA §4633 is enacted to read:

§4633. Sexual orientation

The provisions of this chapter relating to discrimination based on sexual orientation in employment or public accommodations do not apply to a nongovernmental employer or organization that is primarily engaged in providing services to persons under the age of 18 years.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that the protections afforded by the bill do not extend to nongovernmental employers that are primarily engaged in serving minors.
