SENATE AMENDMENT "C " to S.P. 92, L.D. 246, Bill, "An Act to Prevent Discrimination"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 6. 5 MRSA §4633 is enacted to read:


§4633. Sexual orientation

The provisions of this chapter relating to use of public accommodations by persons of a particular sexual orientation protect only individuals and may not be construed to require equal access by a group or organization.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that those portions of the bill relating to use of public accommodations are limited to discrimination against individuals and do not require that equal access to accommodations be provided to a group or organization.
