SENATE AMENDMENT "E " to S.P. 92, L.D. 246, Bill, "An Act to Prevent Discrimination"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 6. 5 MRSA §4633 is enacted to read:


§4633. Sexual orientation

The provisions of this chapter related to sexual orientation protect a person from discrimination that is based solely on that person's status or tendency and do not protect or endorse behavior, whether or not related to that status or tendency.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a new section to clarify that the prohibition against discrimination does not endorse behaviors or provide protection to behaviors as opposed to a status or tendency.
