SENATE AMENDMENT "F " to S.P. 92, L.D. 246, Bill, "An Act to Prevent Discrimination"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §4553, sub-§9-A is enacted to read:

9-A. Sexual orientation. "Sexual orientation" means having a preference for heterosexuality, homosexuality or bisexuality, having a history of the preference or being identified with that preference. This subsection does not include or incorporate any form of conduct or sexual behavior and may not be construed to include or incorporate any form of conduct or behavior.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that the definition of sexual orientation that underlies the prohibition against discrimination does not include conduct or behavior.
