COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 98, L.D. 251

2 This bill requires the Department of Professional and  
 4 Financial Regulation to refund all amounts collected from  
 6 licensing and examination fees paid by individuals under the  
 8 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32, chapter 60. Since the Board of  
 Licensure of Railroad Personnel does not have sufficient  
 resources to return these fees, a General Fund appropriation to  
 the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation of  
 \$34,600 in fiscal year 1993-94 is required.'
