STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment allows a municipality to enact an ordinance regulating ice fishing shacks on sources of public water supply, or portions of those water supply sources, located within that municipality. The amendment also clarifies that the general prohibition on municipal regulation of ice fishing shacks in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 7035, subsection 1, paragraph B, does not apply to coastal waters.
