HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 202,  
L.D. 264, Bill, "An Act Regarding Motorized Wheelchairs"

Amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of  
subsection 9-D and inserting in its place the following:

'9-D. Pedestrian. "Pedestrian" means a person on foot or  
an operator of a wheelchair or a 4-wheeled or 3-wheeled motorized  
wheelchair.'
